UNIFORM, NEAT DRESS AND PRESENTATION

Failure by some students to comply with the Uniform and Dress Code gives rise to a lot of unnecessary conflict and hassle in school, particularly for Year Heads. The Uniform Code was agreed by all partners and must now be followed by all parties without exception.

The onus is on each student to be organised each morning and to wear the uniform in its totality each day. The support of parents in ensuring that students comply with the uniform regulation is expected. Any student who is not in full uniform should remain at home and if they come to school in an incomplete uniform, they may not be allowed into class, parents may be called either at home or at their place of work and asked to take the student home. Students are expected to wear their uniform in a neat and tidy fashion. It is unacceptable for any student to alter the prescribed design of the uniform in any way.

However, if there are medical reasons why a student should be in breach of any part of the dress code please submit to the Year Head a Medical Certificate supporting the request.

Please note that full uniform must be worn during the State Examinations.

GIRLS UNIFORM

- Red round neck jumper with Crest.
- White shirt/blouse with collar/white polo shirt embossed with school name.
- Tartan uniform skirt, not shorter than knee length/Navy Uniform trousers (no denims, cords or brushed cotton).
- School Uniform Jacket with Crest (No initials on outside).
- Black Tights/Black Socks.
- **Fully Black** shoes or runners with black laces - no boots allowed.



BOYS UNIFORMS

- Navy round neck jumper with Crest.
- Blue collared shirt/blue polo shirt embossed with school name.
- Navy Uniform trousers (no denims, cords or brushed cotton).
- School Uniform Jacket with Crest (No initials on outside).
- Black Socks.
- **Fully Black** shoes or runners with black laces - no boots allowed.



Please note: Only the official school jacket can be worn inside the school buildings, no other non-uniform jackets/hoodies will be permitted. Full uniform (jumper and shirt) **must** be worn underneath the jacket **at all times**.

HAIR STYLES

The issue of interpretation of these regulations is a matter solely for the school. Parents/Guardians and students are advised that the implementation of these regulations is the responsibility of staff, the Deputy Principal and the Principal.
